TEMPLATE TERMS OF USE

1 APPLICATION OF TERMS

- 1.1 You may access and use the Templates for your own lawful business purposes in accordance with these Terms. These Terms apply whenever you access or use the Templates.
- 1.2 If you access or use a Template:
 - a you agree to these Terms; and
 - b where your access and use is on behalf of another person (e.g. a company), you confirm that you are authorised to, and do in fact, agree to these Terms on that person's behalf and that, by agreeing to these Terms on that person's behalf, that person is bound by these Terms.
- 1.3 If you do not agree to these Terms, you are not authorised to access and use the Templates, and you must immediately stop doing so.

2 **DEFINITIONS**

In these Terms:

Derived Document includes:

- a copy of a Template;
- a copy of a Template with Placeholder Text completed;
- a modified version of a Template;
- a new work that contains a material part of a Template;
- a compilation of works that includes a Template or a material part of a Template; and
- any of the above made on your behalf, including by your legal services provider

including and similar words do not imply any limit

legal services provider includes lawyers, conveyancers and patent and trade mark attorneys in private practice, but does not include in-house lawyers providing legal advice to their employers

legal services has the meaning given in the New Zealand Lawyers and Conveyancers Act 2006, and includes equivalent services in any other jurisdiction and professional services provided by patent or trade mark attorney

Loss includes loss of profits, savings, revenue or data, and any other claim, damage, loss, liability and cost, including legal costs on a solicitor and own client basis

person includes a legal partnership (whether incorporated or not)

personal information means information about an identifiable, living person

Placeholder Text means text in a Template in [*square brackets*] around black/italics text that indicates that requested details need to be inserted

Simmonds Stewart, we, us or *our* means the New Zealand incorporated law firm Simmonds Stewart Limited, trading as Simmonds Stewart, including any successor partnership or incorporated law firm

Template means a template document made available on or through the Website, including any document created using a document generator we make available on the Website.

Terms means these terms and conditions titled Template Terms of Use

Underlying System means any network, system, software, data or material that underlies or is connected to the Templates or the Website

Website means simmondsstewart.com

words in the singular include the plural and vice versa

you means you or, if clause 1.2b applies, both you and the other person on whose behalf you are acting.

3 USE OF TEMPLATES

- 3.1 There is no charge for use of the Templates in accordance with these Terms.
- 3.2 You must use the Templates or Derived Documents solely for lawful purposes and:
 - a if you are not a legal services provider, for your own internal business purposes, including for documenting transactions between you and third parties or providing any Template or Derived Document to a legal services provider of your choice to:
 - i obtain legal advice relating to the Template or Derived Document; or
 - ii to modify for your use in accordance with these Terms. You must, when doing so, inform your legal services provider that the Template or Derived Document has been obtained from us and provide your legal services provider with a copy of these Terms (or direct them to these Terms on our Website). You must procure your legal services provider to not use the Template or Derived Document other than as permitted under these Terms; or
 - b if you are a legal services provider, for the purpose of making Templates and Derived Documents available to your clients as part of the provision of legal advice, for the internal

business purposes of your clients (including for documenting transactions between those clients and third parties).

- 3.3 You:
 - may view, copy, modify or adapt a Template, and make Templates and Derived
 Documents available to third parties (including, in the case of a legal services provider, providing legal advice to your clients), subject to your compliance with these Terms; and
 - b must remove all proprietary notices and all references to us if you modify the Templates, other than by the completion of Placeholder Text and the selection of options provided in the Templates.
- 3.4 You must not:
 - a sell, sublicense, or otherwise deal in or commercialise the Templates or Derived Documents (including charging any person to use the Templates or Derived Documents or using the Templates or Derived Documents to attract or retain website or application visitors or traffic), except as expressly permitted by these Terms; or

4 CONDITION OF AVAILABILITY AND USE

- 6.1 We (and our licensors) own all proprietary and intellectual property rights in the Templates.
- 6.2 Subject to clause 6.3, you will own the modifications that you make to the Templates, other than modifications that are copies or adaptations of the Templates (in whole or in part). Despite this, these Terms apply to all Derived Documents.
- 6.3 If you provide us with ideas, comments or suggestions relating to the Templates or Website (together **feedback**):
 - a all intellectual property rights in that feedback, and anything created as a result of that feedback (including new material, enhancements, modifications or derivative works), are owned solely by us; and
 - b we may use or disclose the feedback for any purpose.

7 DISCLAIMERS

- 7.1 To the extent permitted by law, we and our licensors have no liability or responsibility to you or any other person for any Loss in connection with:
 - a any modification or adaptation you make to a Template or Derived Document;
 - b any Template being unavailable (in whole or in part);
 - c any information or content contained in a Template, including any error or omission, or information or content that is out-of-date;
 - d any exposure to viruses or other forms of interference which may damage your computer system or expose you to fraud when you access or use the Templates or the Website. To avoid doubt, you are responsible for ensuring the process by which you access and use the Templates and the Website protects you from this; and
 - e any site linked from a Template or the Website. Any link in a Template or on the Website to other sites does not imply any endorsement, approval or recommendation of, or responsibility for, those sites or their contents, operations, products or operators.
- 7.2 The Templates are based on New Zealand law. We make no representation or warranty that the Templates are appropriate or available for use in other countries or that the content satisfies the laws of other countries. 8 LIABILITY

- 8.1 To the maximum extent permitted by law:

This exclusion applies regardless of whether the liability or responsibility arises in contract, tort (including negligence), equity, breach of statutory duty, or otherwise.
- 8.2 You indemnify us against all Loss we suffer or incur as a direct or indirect result of:
 - a your failure to comply with these Terms, including any failure of a person who accesses and uses our Templates using your LinkedIn or other login; or
 - b your use of a Template or Derived Document, including any transaction you enter into using a Template or Derived Document; and
 - c in the case of legal service providers, any advice, Templates or Derived Documents provided by you to your clients.
- 8.3 You agree and represent that you are acquiring the Templates for the purposes of a business. The parties agree that:
 - a to the maximum extent permitted by law, the New Zealand Consumer Guarantees Act 1993 does not apply to the supply of the Templates or these Terms; and

- 8.4 Where legislation or rule of law implies a condition or warranty that cannot be excluded or modified by contract, the condition or warranty is deemed to be included in these Terms. However, our liability for any breach of that condition or warranty is limited, at our option, to:
 - a supplying the relevant Template again; and/or
 - b NZD10.

9 PRIVACY POLICY

9.1 We will require limited personal information (e.g. your email address) from you in order to make the Templates available to you.

- 9.2 If you provide us with your LinkedIn (or other social media) account login details, we may, and you authorise us to, access and collect information available on your social media account profile page, in accordance with any privacy settings you have set for that social media account.
- 9.3 When you provide personal information to us, we will comply with the New Zealand Privacy Act 1993 and our <u>privacy policy</u>.

10 SUSPENSION AND TERMINATION

- 10.1 Your rights under these Terms will terminate automatically on any breach by you of these Terms.
- 10.2 Without prejudice to any other right or remedy available to us, if we consider that you have breached these Terms or we otherwise consider it appropriate, we may immediately, and without notice, suspend or terminate your access to and use of the Templates and Derived Documents.
- 10.3 On suspension or termination, you must immediately cease using the Templates and Derived Documents and must not attempt to gain further access.

11 CHANGES

- 11.1 We may change these Terms at any time by updating them on the Website. Unless stated otherwise, any change takes effect immediately. You are responsible for ensuring you are familiar with the latest Terms. By accessing the Templates at the Website at any time following the change to these Terms, you agree to be bound by the changed Terms.
- 11.2 We may suspend, discontinue or restrict access to the Templates at any time without notice or liability to you.
- 11.3 We may change, modify or remove the Templates at any time without notice or liability to you. Some changes may be to reflect matters of law. Therefore, we encourage you to check back regularly to confirm that you are using the latest version of each Template.

12 GENERAL

- 12.1 If we need to contact you, we may do so by email or by posting a notice on the Website. You agree that this satisfies all legal requirements in relation to written communications.
- 12.2 These Terms, and any dispute relating to these Terms, the Templates or Derived Documents, are governed by and must be interpreted in accordance with the laws of New Zealand. Each party submits to the non-exclusive jurisdiction of the Courts of New Zealand in relation to any dispute connected with these Terms, the Templates or Derived Documents.
- 12.3 For us to waive a right under these Terms, the waiver must be in writing.

- 12.4 Clauses which, by their nature, are intended to survive termination of these Terms, including clauses 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10.3, 12.2, and 12.6, continue in force.
- 12.5 If any part or provision of these Terms is or becomes illegal, unenforceable, or invalid, that part or provision is deemed to be modified to the extent required to remedy the illegality, unenforceability or invalidity. If a modification is not possible, the part or provision must be treated for all purposes as severed from these Terms. The remainder of these Terms will be binding on you.
- 12.6 These Terms set out everything agreed between us relating to your use of the Templates and Derived Documents and supersede and cancel anything discussed, exchanged or agreed prior to you agreeing to these Terms. You have not relied on any representation, warranty or agreement relating to the subject matter of the Terms that is not expressly set out in the Terms, and no such representation, warranty or agreement has any effect from the date you agreed to these Terms. Without limiting the previous sentence, the parties agree to contract out of sections 9, 12A and 13 of the New Zealand Fair Trading Act 1986, and it is fair and reasonable that the parties are bound by this clause 12.6.
